

New Universal Spreader

From now on, a new Universal Spreader is available from HAWE-Wester, the trailer specialist from Wipplingen, Emsland in Germany. And another innovation is that all spreaders from the company will be produced with new sidewalls from now on.

More load volume

The new Universal Spreader DST 24 T-S features longer bodywork to give load volume capacity of 20 cubic meters and, with that, is now the largest spreader with tandem running gear. It is offered with low level hitch, drawbar suspension, tag steering axle, 700/50x26.5 tyres and heavy duty drive components with appropriate overload security systems as well as E-comfort controls with rpm monitoring – all as standard equipment.

With this, HAWE-Wester meets market demands for more transport volume and offers a trailer system with low draught requirement, soil-protecting low ground pressure tyres and high operating comfort. At the same time this well-known German manufacturer extends its range of spreaders with yet another model, now offering a total of seven different universal spreaders, two of them with tridem running gear.

New sidewalls and spreader rotors

All spreaders are now supplied with new sidewalls that help retain the models' well-known stability and robustness but with reduced weight. The smooth wall interiors also improve spreading material movement. The spreading rotors have been further developed, too. Their open design reduces power requirement and sinks diesel consumption by 20 to 30 percent.

Huge choice

In total, customers can choose between seven Universal Spreaders from 12 to 32 tonnes (13 to 23 m³) capacity and four Manure Spreaders from 8 to 20 tonne registered gross weight (11 to 17.5 m³ heaped load volume). The Manure Spreaders are in demand from farms that need to spread manure only. These cost a little less. On the other hand, Universal Spreaders allow all spreadable bulk goods to be handled.

All HAWE Universal Spreaders are fitted with high-quality BPW axles. Additionally, all the usual hitch systems to be found on the market are offered as well as the various mechanical, hydraulic and even pneumatic suspensions. The tandem and tridem trailers can alternatively be built as body-swap systems so that as well as spreader bodywork other bodies can be used (dumpers, push-off trailers, field transfer trailers).

DLG tested

Through optimisation of the spreader aggregate a high distribution precision has been achieved with the HAWE Universal Spreader. And the same result has been reached by simple height and width adjustment of the lower spreader gate allowing all spreading materials to be distributed even more precisely and finely. HAWE maintains close contact with farmers and contractors and integrates customer wishes into designs rapidly and consequently. The spreaders are robust, reliable, long-lived and cost-effective. On top of this, the 2008 innovations effectively reduce tractor fuel consumption, so sinking variable costs.
